RYAN LIPMAN, 8, FIRST TOOK THE ICE AT 4 YEARS OLD IN THE US FIGURE SKATING (USFS) LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAM IN LAUREL, MD. HE QUICKLY PROGRESSED THROUGH SNOWPLOW SAM AND BASIC 1-2 SO THAT HE COULD TRANSITION TO THE LEARN TO PLAY HOCKEY PROGRAM. HIS FAMILY RELOCATED TO FLORIDA THE FOLLOWING YEAR, AND HE CONTINUED TO TAKE GROUP AND PRIVATE LESSONS TO FURTHER BUILD HIS HOCKEY SKILLS, ULTIMATELY EARNING A SPOT ON A LOCAL TRAVEL TEAM LATER THAT YEAR. THOUGH RYAN LOVED HOCKEY, HE ALSO SHOWED AN INTEREST IN EXPRESSING HIMSELF ARTISTICALLY ON THE ICE AND DOING JUMPS AND SPINS. IN EARLY 2021 AT THE SUGGESTION OF HIS PRIVATE SKATING COACH, CALLA URBANSKI-PETKA, RYAN TRIED FIGURE SKATING. HE EXCELLED IN FIGURE SKATING AND AFTER COMPLETING THE HOCKEY SEASON, CHOSE TO RETIRE HIS HOCKEY SKATES IN FAVOR OF FIGURE SKATES. RYAN HAS QUICKLY PROGRESSED IN FIGURE SKATING EARNING A BRONZE MEDAL AT THE 2022 USFS EXCEL NATIONAL FESTIVAL, AND GOLD MEDALS AT THE 2022 STATE GAMES OF AMERICA. HE IS CURRENTLY COMPETING AT THE JUVENILE LEVEL IN THE USFS NATIONAL QUALIFYING SERIES AND DREAMS OF BEING A MEMBER OF TEAM USA WHEN HE IS OLDER.
